## DOWNLOAD

Go to [www.pdfreactor.com/download](http://www.pdfreactor.com/download) and download a PDFreactor package suitable for your system environment. (Skip this step for Docker.)

If you don't have a license key you can get a trial key at <http://www.pdfreactor.com/request-trial/>.

## INSTALLATION

-  Run the Windows installer
-  Unpack the archive or use the RPM \*
-  Run the macOS installer
-  Run `docker pull realobjects/pdfreactor`
-  Import the JAR and POM into your Maven repo

\* Requires a separate Java installation

## INTEGRATION

- **PDFreactor Library:** From your local repo, include the `com.pdfreactor.pdfreactor` artifact in your Java app.
- **PDFreactor Web Service:**  
**JavaScript, .NET, Node, PHP, Python, Ruby:**  
Copy the client that matches your integration language from the `clients/` directory.  
**REST/SOAP:** Visit <http://localhost:9423/service/> for information.

## CONVERSION

```
PDFreactor pdfReactor = new PDFreactor();  
Configuration config = new Config();  
  
config.setDocument(  
    "<html><body>Hello World</body></html>");  
Result result = pdfReactor.convert(config);  
byte[] pdfBytes = result.getDocument();
```
