## DOWNLOAD

Go to [www.pdfreactor.com/download](http://www.pdfreactor.com/download) and download a PDFReactor package suitable for your system environment.

If you don't have a license key you can get a trial key at <http://www.pdfreactor.com/request-trial/>.

## INSTALLATION

Open the PDFReactor package you just downloaded and...

-  run the Windows installer
-  unpack the archive or use the RPM \*
-  run the macOS installer

\* Requires a separate Java installation

## INTEGRATION

**Java library:** Add the `PDFReactor/lib/pdfreactor.jar` file to your project's classpath.

**.NET, PHP, Python, Perl, Ruby, JavaScript:** Go to the `PDFReactor/clients/` directory and copy the library that matches your integration language.

**REST or SOAP:** Visit <http://localhost:9423/service/> for more information.

PDFReactor pdfReactor = new PDFReactor();
Configuration config = new Config();
config.setDocument(
    "<html><body>Hello World</body></html>");
Result result = pdfReactor.convert(config);
byte[] pdfBytes = result.getDocument();
```
